#### **Discussion:**

- US is OK with 2<sup>nd</sup> choice of Cybersecurity; does expect to include other experts on the other Focus Groups as well.
- o Hungary has reservations about leading a Focus Group independently.
- Japan would like to serve as co-chair of Security Culture with Hungary; prefers to participate than lead National Policy & Regulatory Frameworks Focus Group.
- Canada needs to internally discuss serving as a lead for their 2<sup>nd</sup> choice of Security Culture; as their current experts for INFCIRC/908 are mostly in the Physical Protection area. \*\*UPDATE\*\*Canada will co-lead Physical Protection & Technical Measures along with Israel, Malaysia, and Nigeria.
  Recognizing that Physical Protection & Technical Measures is a broad topic, involvement of several interested Steering Committee members is a benefit.
- o Belgium is lonesome, but will take lead on Trustworthiness & Reliability; Happy to welcome a partner from within and outside the SC.

#### FOCUS GROUP TOPIC CONFIGURATION AND PLANNING

**Proposal:** All groups meet, discuss scope, how their topic may integrate with National Policy & Regulatory Frameworks. Come back as a group to determine what resources are needed, as well as schedule and outline of focus group activities for the next year.
