What is the Joint Statement on Mitigating Insider Threats (INFCIRC/908)?

Issued by the United States at the 2016 IAEA *International Conference on Nuclear Security*, the Joint Statement on Mitigating Insider Threats, [Information Circular 908 \(INFCIRC/908\)](#), seeks to build awareness of insider threats that pose serious risk to the security of nuclear and other radioactive materials.

Subscribing nations commit to:

- Support the IAEA to develop and implement an advanced, practitioner-level training course on insider threat mitigation, and
- Implement measures to mitigate insider risk by taking a risk-informed, graded approach.

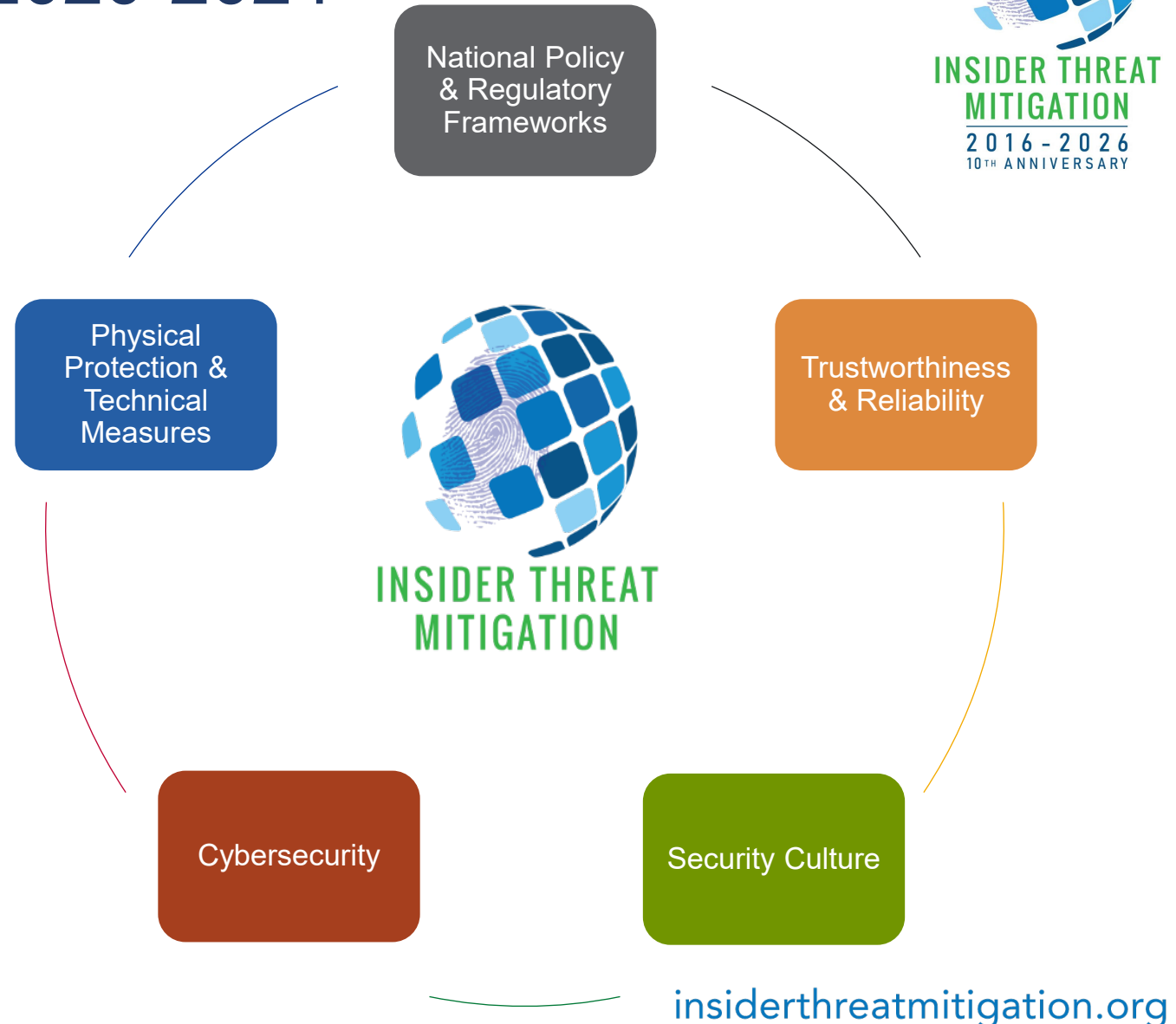

Following the Symposium, the Advancing INFCIRC/908 IWG focused on four critical areas:

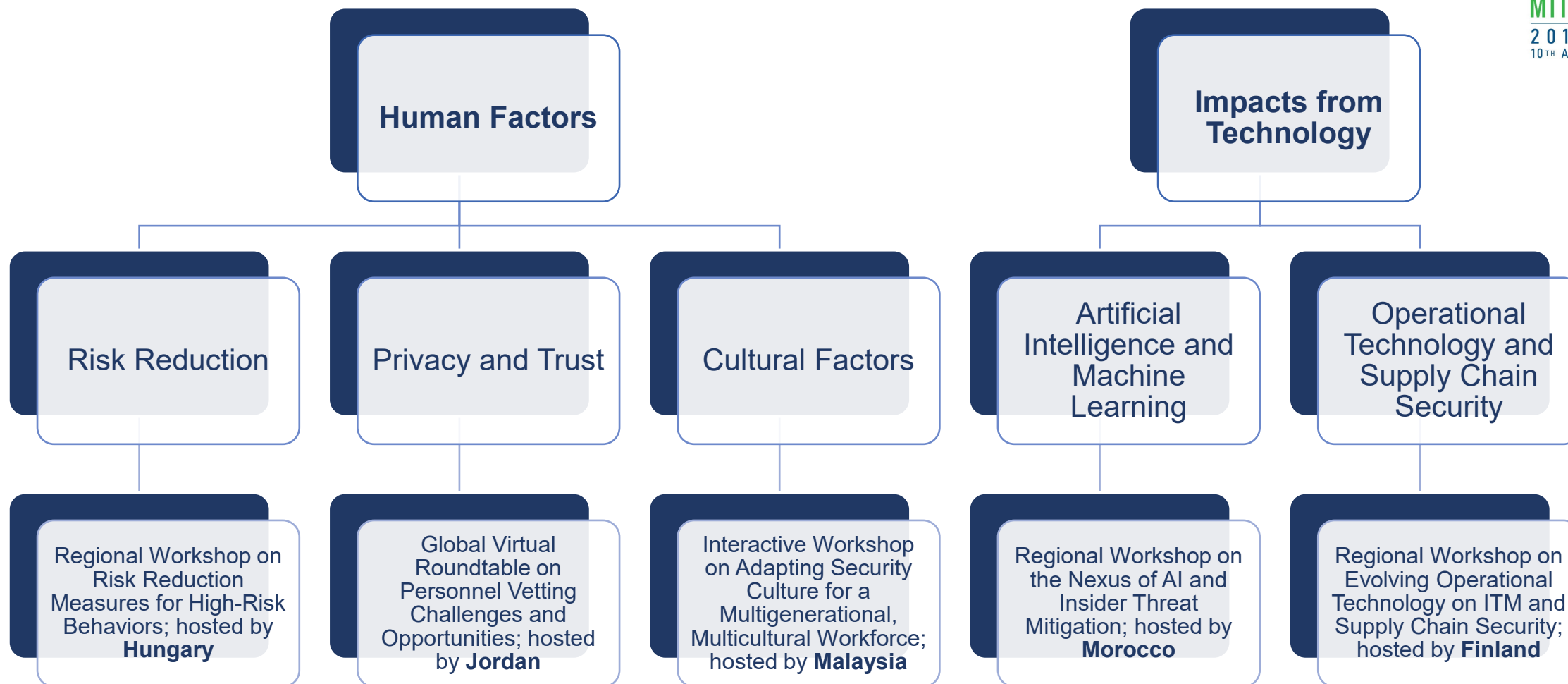
1. **Circulate** Revision 1 to INFCIRC/908 among subscribing member states
2. **Sunset** the original five focus groups and reorganize to focus on regional impacts on global nuclear security.
3. **Evolve** Steering Committee membership
4. **Focus** on *Human Factors* and the *Impacts of Technology* on the effective implementation of insider threat mitigation programs for future IWG workplan activities.

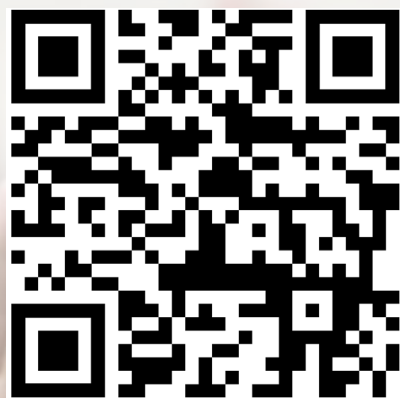
